The Prayer Shawl Ministry meets once a month on the 3rd Saturday of the month. Folks get together to share the projects they're working

on, get inspiration, and just visit with friends :)

You don't need to be a knitter or crocheter to join the prayer shawl ministry! The group has also become involved in the creation of plarn mats for the unhomed. As such, they **need folks who are willing to wield a pair of scissors and cut up plastic bags into 'plarn' (plastic yarn), and folks to string those cut up loops of plastic onto carboard tubes** so that they can be used to knit and crochet the plarn mats.

The next meeting will be this **Saturday, September 16, 2023 at 9:30am** in Burton Hall. Looking forward to seeing you all there!

Also the next **PLARN** event is coming up **Saturday, Sept 23rd** at Trinity Southern Baptist off on Trezell. It will be in their Fellowship Hall which is off of East Trinity Place street from 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM. Over 20 mats have been made since these events started in March this year. Not only has this directly benefited the unhomed in our community, it has kept somewhere between 10k - 17k plastic bags out of our local landfill. A big thank you to Kari Davis who has been spearheading this campaign since the beginning.

tell me all about it.*

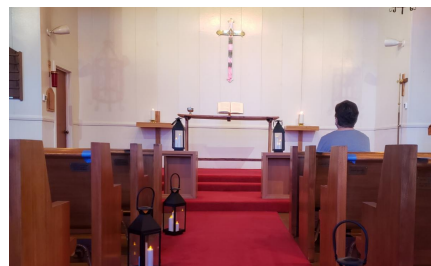
*Thirdly, we're all about relationships. We hope to cultivate and grow

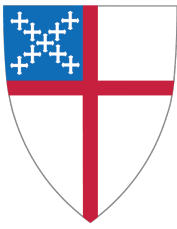
