This takes place on **Zoom @ 12pm on Thursdays,**

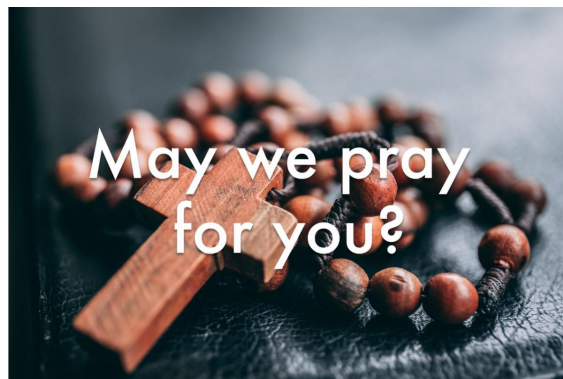

Office Hours

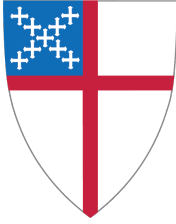
The office will be open this coming week Tuesday thru Friday.
